## **Activities done During the year 2018-19:**

### **1. To enable and strengthening the quality of education for outreach children for the society.**

Education is the most powerful weapon which can use to change the world and the most effective way to break out of the cycle of poverty. Still many children remain out-of-school in India. These children are not only deprived of their right to receive an education but they migrate to earn of bread. Child migration and trafficking is a major problem in our state.

This year, during visiting in the rural area organisations tried to make aware parents and community about child trafficking and to get help from child line. Organisation distributed books and copies among the children of Khatanga basti and Bharno vidhyalaya, gumla.

Organisation also ensured them that they are interested to provide scholarship, and other essentials required things for strengthening the education.

We also did an interaction with the mukhia of that village Roshni Kumari, about the importance of education and her role to bring change in the village scerio. We motivated her that the individual can bring change about with small efforts.

### **2. Relief support and Help for needy and destitute, widows**

In Jharkhand no. of widows and single women no is very high because drinking is in custom and most of the male died because bad practice of drunken habit. Child marriage is also a big region, Girls itself marriage without parents consent. Girls or women rescued from metropolitans also kept in the Nari Niketan but still they are facing lots of problem in village as well as nari Niketan. Throughout life they also face many challenges include social exclusion, discrimination in inheritance rights, violence, and even abandonment by families in old age. Even if there are laws to protect widows and government sanctioned pension schemes for widow welfare, most women are simply unaware of their rights.

We helped young widows to stay at Nari Niketan at Gumla and Ranchi. With the support of Jharkhand state food commission helped them to get their ration card on their name.

We visited Nari Niketan, probation home of Ranchi and generated awareness about their rights and also activities include talent mapping, entrepreneurship coaching, and identify to connect them with livelihood activities.

### **3. Encouraged Youths and women to stand up as a entrepreneur.**

To encourage budding entrepreneurs to kick-start innovative businesses that will eventually create employment opportunities, the government offers innumerable schemes to make the process easy.

Awareness program related to these schemes was organized which gave a detailed information about the eligibility criteria and process to apply with help of NGOs and self-help groups and how one could benefit from these schemes and become a small scale entrepreneur. The organisation also helped in making proposals and support them to get required paper and loan from the departments.

### **4. Importance of Personal hygiene and distribution of sanitary napkins among young ladies.**

To reach to a level of sustainability we must focus on prevention, even more than cure, so as to reduce the 'disease burden' on common man. Awareness generation and attitudinal change campaigns and programs. We did awareness of Young lady and adolescents on mensuration



cycle and on importance of personal hygiene. We distributed 300 sanitary napkins in Rahe and ratu villages of Ranchi district.

### **5. Capacity Building of Farmers (Male & Women)**

In Jharkhand it has been seen that most of the agriculture related work is done by women famers but they are not treated as farmer so the organisation tried to Identify such S.H.G and women, engaged in agriculture activities and their families, for the

formation of Farmers producer groups (PG) and farmer producer club, to gain improved access to inputs such as seeds, fingerlings, community-owned irrigation systems, markets, market intelligence, credit, and technical knowledge. FPOs can play an important role in reducing these costs by collectively purchasing than individual purchase. Awareness campaign explaining the importance of these activities was also carried. They were also made aware on organic farming importance.

Awareness program and interaction at field was done about various government schemes for farmer of Skill development

#### **6. Promotion of Skill Development programmes among rural youths**

Awareness campaign was carried so as to make the rural youth aware of the various skill development programs started by the government and how one can benefit from the same. The campaign was done in Chandwe and Vita village at Kanke block and Pirra, Dondai and hehal village at Ratu block.

#### **7. Health Check Camp and distribution of medicines**

The Organisation Has conducted Doctors and Medicine Company for medicine and organised two health camps in the rural area of Namkum block of Ranchi district providing basic check-up of the villages and medications where necessary. Also awareness program was done on prevention and care of common diseases like diarrhoea,



acute respiratory tract infections, tuberculosis (TB), malaria, dengue, typhoid and anaemia & importance of Personal hygiene, Breastfeeding was discussed with the women of that village.

#### **8. Distribution of Blankets**

In the Month of Dec 101 blankets were distributed among the old women of nagri village of kanke block.

## Celebration of National and International Days :

### **1. Campaigning of National Malaria Day as on 24<sup>th</sup> July.**

Seeing rise in the number of malaria and dengue cases in the past few years our team decided to do an awareness campaign on the National Malaria Day, to stop the outbreak of mosquito-borne disease. Our effort was to make the villagers aware about the disease and tell them about do's and don'ts to curb malaria. We appealed villagers to maintain cleanliness, sprinkle DDT and remove water logged and use of mosquito net in their surroundings. Meanwhile some of our members also sprinkled bleaching powder in streets and drains and in nearby school campus.

### **2. Campaign about Literacy Day as on 8<sup>th</sup> Sept**

Education is every child's fundamental right. All girls and boys should have an equal opportunity to learn. Despite the power of education to transform lives, millions of children remain out of school. With the main objectives of ensuring free, quality and inclusive education for all children and their protection from all forms of discrimination and violence a campaign was started on the Literacy day on 8<sup>th</sup> sept. We discussed on Child marriage and child labour are taboos in the society that can be only overcome by generating awareness about education and achieving the basic education and complete literacy for all irrespective of age and gender discrimination. We organised it in Khatanga Basti near Khelgaon. Ranchi.



3. A painting competition was organised on 2<sup>nd</sup> Oct. 35 children participated and discussed on the life of Gandhi jee and also painted portrait prize of the Ghandhi Jee painting was distributed among them.

### **4. Celebration of International Women's Day**

When we empower a woman, we elevate her community. This is the core concept behind our development efforts in the Tribal Belt of India: a ripple effect occurs when we believe in women and invest in





their potential. We are seeing the power of women every day in various fields, where they are creating opportunities for the next generation.

When women and girls have access to education, health care and nutrition, are involved in decision making processes, their families and communities are more productive and stable.

Awareness program was organised at Dhurwa Sector-2 to generate awareness about the importance to education of girl child, gender equality, women empowerment and women rights.
